## 4) Acta Orthopaedica

A formalized **5 year partnership** between the IRSA and the Journal Acta Orthopaedica has been established. This will benefit the members in several ways including the following:

- Indexing of RSA papers under a specific category easy to locate.
- A general 30% article processing charges (APC) for all IRSA members.
- Presenters at IRSA's annual congresses (this year Vancouver) are invited to submit full-length manuscripts for consideration in Acta Orthopaedica with expectations of fast review by RSA experts. The manuscript should be submitted within 4 months after the the congress, and should include a cover letter with the submission, indicating that the manuscript is intended for the IRSAs Congress. For any IRSAS manuscript, a prespecified manuscript type "IRSAS manuscript" should be selected in the Manuscript Manager submission portal. A verification document for IRSAs congress participation must be uploaded with the manuscript.
- The nominated best paper of the biennial IRSA Meeting will be offered a waiver free of charge.
- The radiostereometry.org website will soon be updated with more info.

### 5) IRSA WEBINARS

The IRSA board thank Maaike de Bondt, Nijmegen, Wilhelm Mustad and Jonathan Jürgens-Lahnstein for their valued help with organizing and chairing the IRSA webinars, which we belive has been a great success.
